1. Piston.
2. Hunter (AAFTA Rules Apply).
3. PCP.
4. International (12 ft. lbs.).

COURSE OF FIRE:

120 shots over 2 days on 2 different courses.

Each daily match will consist of 60 shots each, with 2 targets per lane.

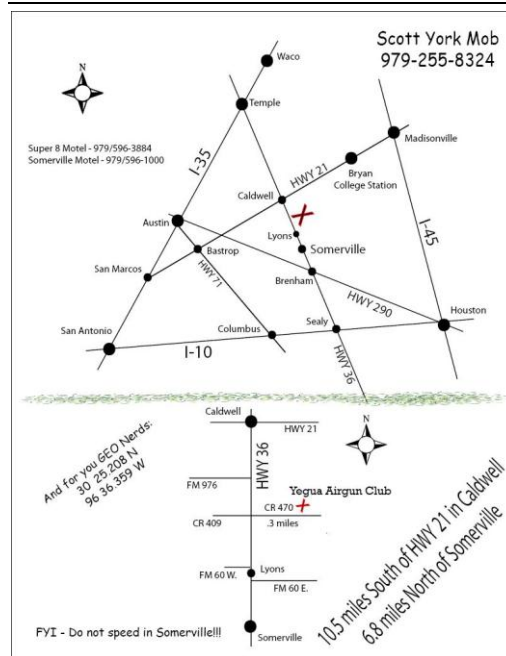
Standing & kneeling shots will be included.

AWARDS:

- 1st – 5th place PCP and Piston;
- 1st – 3rd place Hunter;
- 1st – 3rd place International; **High** Texan;
- High** Junior (under 15); **High** Lady;
- High** Senior (65+); **High** 4 man team;
- 1st - 2nd place Pistol Field Target;
- 1st – 2nd place Night Spotlight Shoot;
- 1st place in all other Side/Fun Shoots.

Any class or division requires a minimum of 3 entrants for awards. The number of awards will be determined by the number of shooters in each class, with one award per every three entrants. I.E. – 6 shooters - 1st & 2nd; 9 shooters - 1st thru 3rd; 12 shooters - 1st thru 4th, etc.

IMPORTANT THINGS:

Rules:

AAFTA rules will be enforced. A match director's meeting will be held before each match.

Airguns must chronograph at **20 ft. lbs. or less. We will spot check guns at random. No exceptions** (if your Daisy Red Rider is knocking over the target holders, and kicking up huge clouds of dust at 50 yards, it will probably get randomly chronied)!

Safety:

AAFTA safety rules will be enforced.

Timers: Will be used on all lanes.

Practice Range Open:

Friday, Feb 29th – 8:00 a.m. to dark,
On match days – 7:00 a.m.

A limited number of shooting benches, a chronograph, practice targets, and spinners will be set up and available on the practice range.

Meals:

Lunches provided Saturday and Sunday for competitors. Guest meals are \$8/meal.

Beverages:

Provided with lunch. Water will be provided on range each day. Competitors are encouraged to bring their own personal water bottles, which they can refill on site.
