RED RYDER BB GUN CHALLENGE

1. The Red Ryder BB Gun Challenge is designed as a fun and entertaining event that challenges shooters off-hand BB gun ability (and to a certain degree, dumb luck). It is not meant as a serious challenge to any particular target skill. Don't take it too seriously!
2. The Match Director has the right to adjust and change the rules to accommodate weather changes, facility availability, match size, and other unforeseen factors that may be present at the time of the Red Ryder BB Gun Challenge. The Match Director also reserves the right to change the rules just cause he wants to!
3. A stock Red Ryder BB Gun (preferably with the little leather strap) must be used. It must have the Red Ryder logo on the stock. No modifications are allowed to the gun, the owners name may appear on the Red Ryder BB gun. There is a good supply of club guns on hand if you can't afford this exceptional wonder of the airgun world, or if you just plain forgot yours.
4. Ammunition will be limited to BBs fed through the barrel feed of the Red Ryder.
5. No scopes or sights other than the original sight on the Red Ryder BB Gun.
6. Targets will be 5 inflated balloons on a horizontal string, 4 feet above the ground at approximately 10 yards from the firing line.
7. The competitor's feet must remain behind the firing line. Stepping or falling over the firing line will result in forfeiting that elimination round.
8. The firing position will be from the off-hand, standing position. No supports allowed under any conditions.
9. Two competitors will be given the commands "Shooters Ready," and "Fire." The first to pop all 5 balloons wins that elimination round.
10. At very large matches three or more competitors may be required for each elimination round. The Match Director is the sole authority in determining if the match is large enough to require more than two competitors in each elimination round.



11. Competition is simple double elimination, with the winner advancing from each round to determine the two competitors for the final round.
12. Once an elimination round has begun every balloon that pops or completely deflates is counted as a hit.
13. Proper gun safety rules must be followed in handling, cocking, firing, and returning the Daisy Red Ryder BB Gun to the gun rack. The Match Director will be actively monitoring safety procedures during the competition and violators will only be given one warning before being eliminated from the competition. Muzzle control has been an issue in past matches (don't point your BB gun at the spectators or the Match Director!!)
14. Final 1st & 2nd place round will be shot on the 2nd day before all awards are given out. The final round determining 1st & 2nd places will be a double elimination round.
